### HUMAN TRAFFICKING 101 AND INTERNET SAFETY

#### **Speaker, Corrine St. Thomas-Stowers**

Corrine St. Thomas-Stowers brings over 20 years of experience in online child protection, human trafficking operational efforts, and actionable intelligence in law enforcement investigations. Her career has been dedicated to law enforcement initiatives to safeguard vulnerable populations through innovative strategies and collaborative partnerships. Corrine has experience working for the Westminster Police Department, the Orange County District Attorney's Office, the National Center for Missing and Exploited Children, and most recently was the Supervising Intelligence Analyst for the Tactical Analysis Unit for the Orange County Intelligence Assessment Center. In addition, she was selected by the Federal Bureau of Investigation to become a Task Force Analyst with the criminal squad in Orange County. Currently, she is an Adjunct Professor at Vanguard University of Southern California in Orange County.

A defining achievement in her career was leading Operation Red Zone, the largest human trafficking law enforcement operation in Orange County's history, which resulted in 56 arrests and the identification of 16 victims. This operation earned national recognition and the Intelligence Analyst of the Year award from the National Fusion Center Association.
